1. ONTVANGS

1. RECEPTION

2. 10th ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATIONS

Bronberg will celebrate its 10th anniversary on 1 October. We will mark this special milestone with an appropriate celebration on Saturday, 3 October 2026. Please save the date and join us in commemorating this significant occasion.

3. KITCHEN STAFF

After more than three years with us in the kitchen, Dani has decided to pursue new opportunities. Marine du Toit has been appointed as her successor. Please join us in welcoming Marine to the Bronberg community and in providing her with the support she needs to settle in successfully.

4. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

This year's Annual General Meeting (AGM) will be held on Tuesday, 25 August 2026. The meeting will commence promptly at 15:00 in the Mandolin Hall. Registration will begin at 14:00 in the reception foyer. We encourage all owners to attend this important meeting.

5. EMERGENCIES

We would like to remind all residents of the emergency procedures at Bronberg. During weekdays between 08:00 and 16:00, all emergencies are managed by the Clinic staff. Please contact the Clinic during these hours if emergency assistance is required. From 16:00 until 08:00, as well as on weekends, all emergencies will be managed by the staff of our Frail Care Centre.

6. PICKET FENCES

The replacement of the wooden picket fences has been on hold for the past three weeks. We plan to resume the replacement programme once the painting of units in Phases 1 and 2 has been completed. If all goes according to plan, work will recommence on Monday, 29 June 2026.

7. VISITORS WITH DOGS

It remains an established rule that visiting dogs are not allowed within the Estate. In 2025, the Board approved a concession allowing visitors with dogs under certain conditions. Residents may apply at Reception for a temporary permit, and provided all required documentation is submitted and approved, such dogs may be allowed onto the Estate.

Visitors who are not in possession of a valid permit will not be granted access by Security. Each permit is valid for one month. If we already have all the relevant certificates for a specific dog on record, residents need only apply at Reception for a permit renewal once it expires.

No dogs are permitted inside the main building. Visitors may not bring dogs when visiting apartments, and residents may not have dogs with them inside the main building.

8. SCHOOL HOLIDAY PERIOD

With the upcoming school holidays approaching, we would like to remind all residents that visitors, children, and grandchildren are not allowed in the Games Room or Gymnasium. In addition, all visitors and children must be accompanied by residents at all times while on the Estate.

9. WATER CONSUMPTION

Last but certainly not least, we have repaired seven major water leaks over the past ten days. Our water consumption has been a source of huge concern and frustration during the past 10 months and although we are not out of the woods yet, it is a massive relief to experience the decrease in our daily water consumption.

Although our consumption levels have not yet returned to where they should be, we ask for everyone's continued cooperation in using water responsibly and sparingly. We are still committed to finding and repairing any remaining leaks and are confident that our new contractor will assist us in locating and resolving these issues.

Thank you for your patience and cooperation over the past ten months in helping us conserve water.
